What credits do I need to graduate from our school?

With my 24 credits, will I get into any post-secondary program I want?

- Not necessarily! Each institution has its own unique prerequisites. You must ensure that you meet entrance requirements specific to that institution.

How do I register for AP courses in Grade 12?

- Talk to the teachers to find out more information about workload and expectations.
- Include AP classes in your My School Sask (MSS) course selections.

What are the Social Sciences?

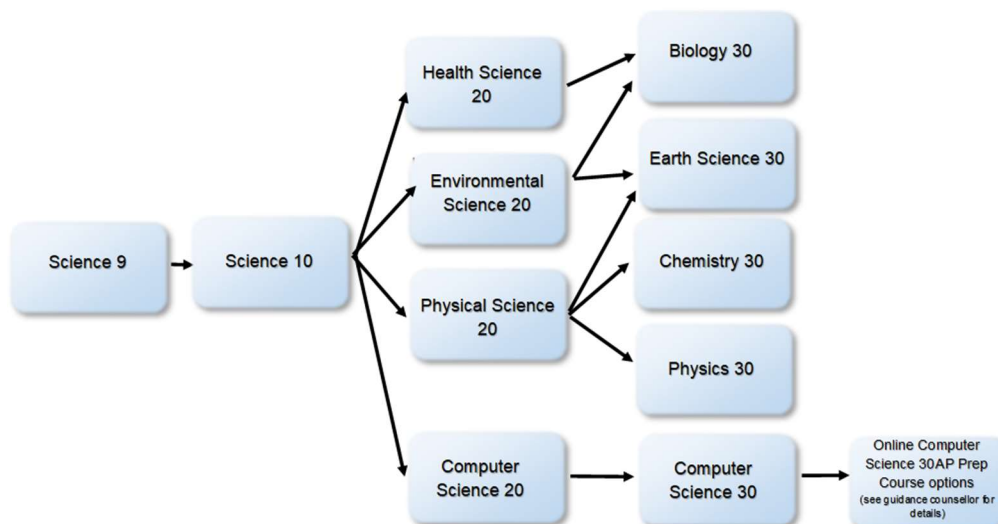
- History 20, Psychology 20 or 30 (AP also counts), or Law 30 - you must take one of these courses in order to meet graduation requirements

How can I find out more about elective subjects?

- Talk with teachers who teach these classes
- Refer to the “Program of Studies” document (available online at www.rcsd.ca/riffel/)
- If you change your mind later on, the elective you want could be full, so select carefully.
- Riffel will be hosting a “Course Selection Fair” in the Commons Area on **Tuesday, February 25th, 2025 at lunch.**

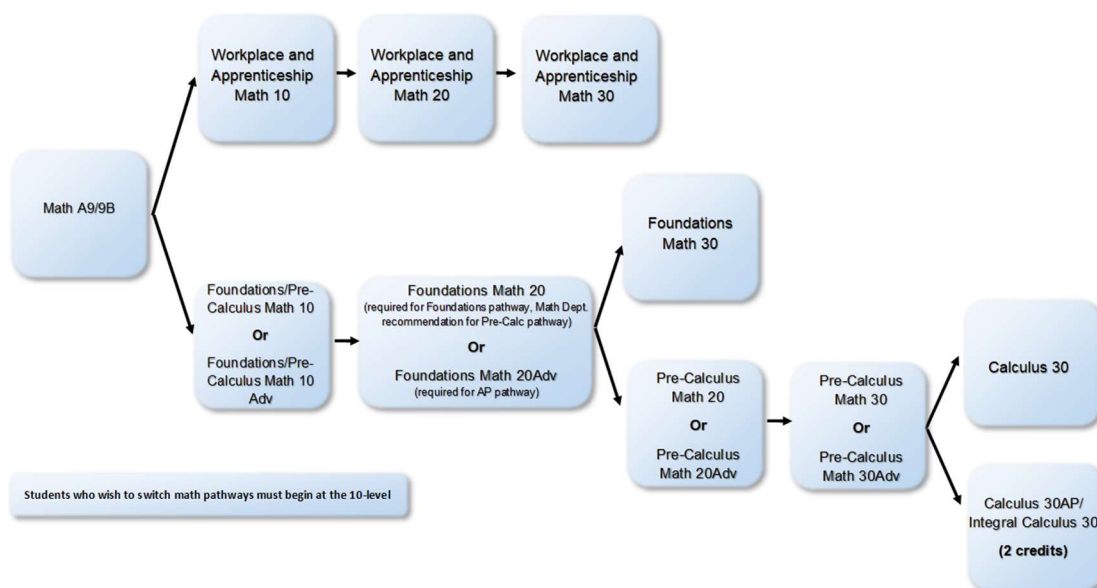
Which 20 and 30 level science should I take?

- Allow your interests, post-secondary plans and career goals guide your decisions.
- The pre-requisite for Physics 30 & Chemistry 30 is Physical Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Biology 30 is Health Science 20 or Environmental Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Computer Science 30 is Computer Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Earth Science 30 is Environmental Science 20 or Physical Science 20



What math courses should I take?

- Be sure to include any unmet graduation requirement (20-level math)
- Investigate admission requirements for programs of interest to ensure the appropriate selection of courses.



What if I failed a Grade 11 subject?

- If you failed a compulsory subject, please include this course in your Grade 12 course selections or speak to a Guidance Counsellor regarding Summer School.
- Plan on taking a full course load each semester of Grade 12 to make up for failed courses and to ensure that you have 24 credits to graduate
- You need to take a minimum of 7 courses in Grade 12 to be eligible for honour roll **Subject to change*
- You need to take a minimum of 8 face to face courses in Grade 12 to apply for a parking pass **Subject to change*
- It is up to **YOU** to keep track of the credits you have earned. Please review your credit history on a Personal Graduation Checklist, available on the Riffel Student Services Website or on the back of this booklet.

When is the 2025-2026 registration deadline?

- Course registration is done through My School Sask (MSS) – **Wednesday, February 26th, 2024 to Wednesday, March 5th, 2024**
