Course Selection Information for Current Grade 9 Students

How many classes do I take in grade 10?

- You must take 10 classes in Grade 10
- Band, Choral and Vocal Jazz are possible additions

What if I failed a grade nine compulsory subject?

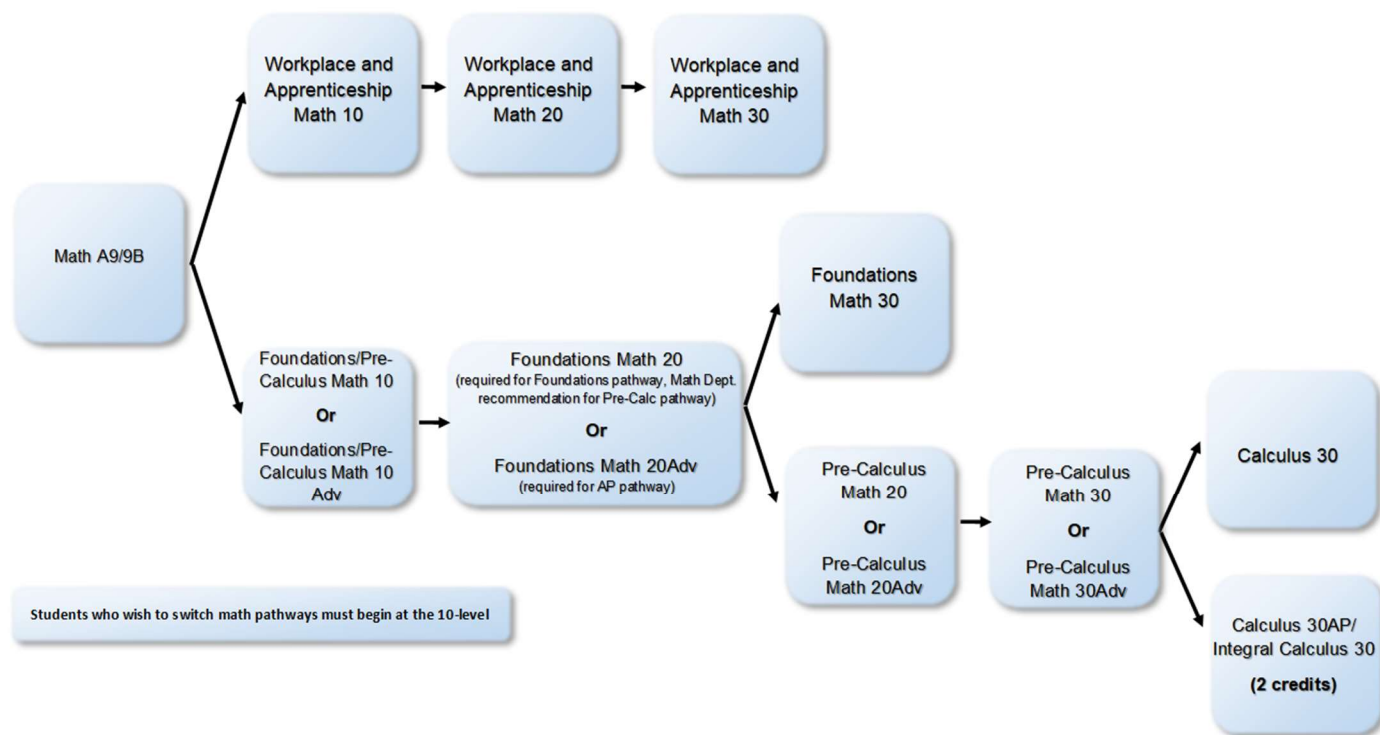
- If you failed ELA, Social, Science, Math, or Catholic Studies & are not going to summer school, select that course as part of your course selection in My School Sask (MSS). This course will take the place of one grade 10 elective.
- NOTE:** Summer School is highly recommended so that you can stay on track and finish high school in four years.

What credits do I need to graduate from Riffel?

Which Math 10 pathway should I take?

- Allow your post-secondary plans to guide your decision regarding pathway
- You can choose both W/A and F/P at the grade 10 level and commit to your pathway in grade 11
- If you plan to take Calculus later, you should take F/P 10 (Sem 1) and Foundations 20 (Sem 2)



How can I find out more about elective subjects?

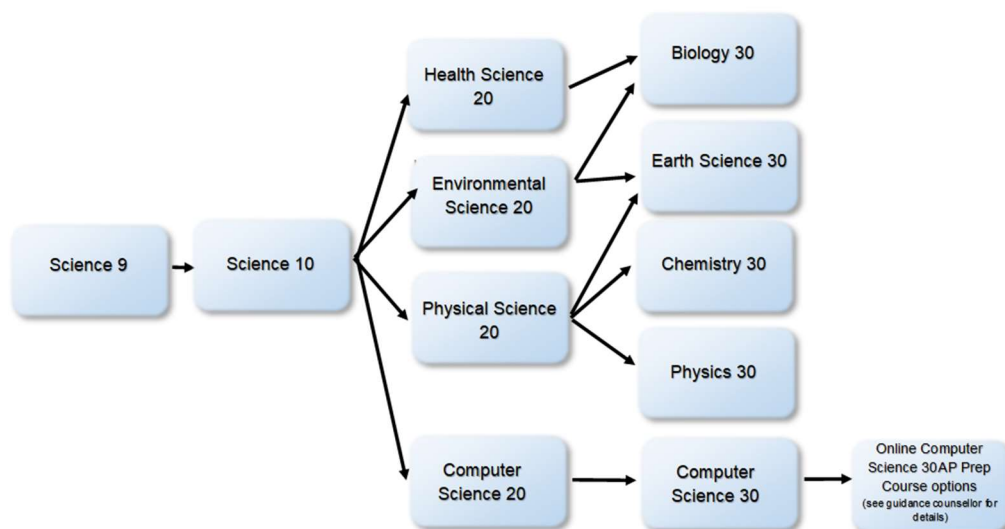
- Talk with the teachers who teach the classes

What is a Social Science?

- Social Sciences include History 20, Psychology 20 or 30, or Law 30. These cannot be taken at the grade 10 level. Keep these as elective options in mind as you move to Grade 11.

Which 20 level science should I take?

- Allow your interests, post-secondary plans and career goals to guide your decision.



What if I am interested in working toward Advanced Placement Courses in Grade 12?

- Discuss this with your current Math, English, or Art teachers and your parents/guardians
- See a Guidance Counsellor for more information
- If you are already taking advanced classes (and if you want to continue), check off the courses on the form that make up the next step in tracking toward AP courses in Grade 12 (ELA and Math are denoted using AD)
- You may opt in or out of AP courses at the end of the semester (scheduling/space permitted).

- On-line registration - done at home through My School Sask (MSS) takes place from **Wednesday, February 26th, 2025 to Wednesday, March 5th, 2025**
