How many classes must I take in Grade 11?

- A full schedule is always recommended
- Students must take a minimum of 8 (not including Band, Choral or Vocal Jazz)

What if I failed a Grade 10 subject?

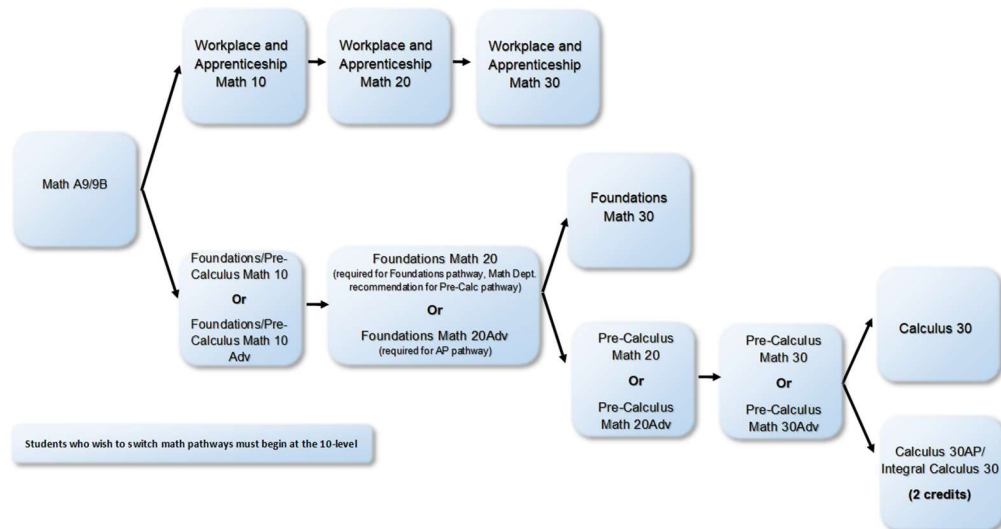
- If you failed a compulsory subject, select this class when entering your Grade 11 course choices into MSS, or speak to a Guidance Counsellor regarding summer school.

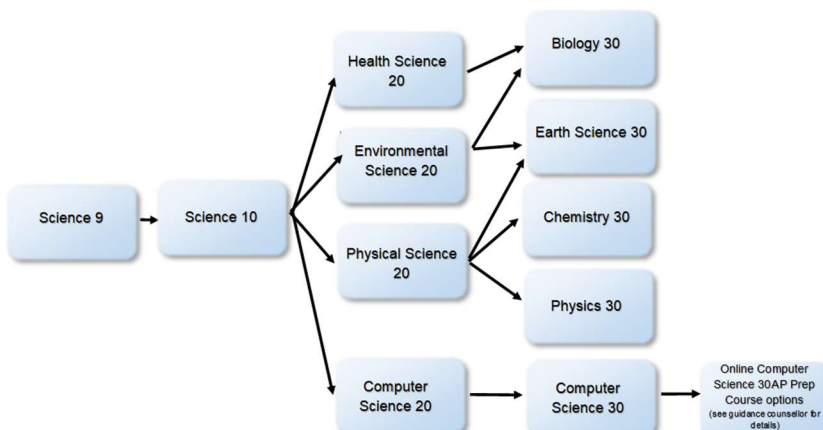
What math courses should I take?

- The answer will depend on your career path. Start checking post-secondary requirements now to ensure that you have the correct math admission requirement. Use myBlueprint (myBlueprint.ca)



Which 20 and 30 level science should I take?

- Allow your interests, post-secondary plans and career goals guide your decisions
- The pre-requisite for Physics 30 & Chemistry 30 is Physical Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Biology 30 is Health Science 20 or Environmental Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Earth Science 30 is Environmental Science 20 or Physical Science 20
- The pre-requisite for Computer Science 30 is Computer Science 20



With my 24 credits, will I get into any post-secondary program I want?

- Not necessarily! Each institution has unique prerequisites. You must ensure that you meet entrance requirements
- Log into myBlueprint.ca
- Begin researching programs and institutions of interest.
- See a Guidance Counsellor for assistance

Can I take subjects from other grade levels in Grade 11?

- With the exception of science and math, students **may not** take compulsory subjects from higher grades
- As long as students meet the prerequisite requirements, students **can** take 30-level elective courses.
- Students can take also take 10-level courses.
- Riffel will be hosting a “Course Selection Fair” in the Commons Area on **Tuesday, February 25th, 2025** at lunch to explore elective options.

What if I am interested in Advanced Placement courses in Grade 11 or 12?

- Discuss this with your Math, English, or Art teachers and with your parents/guardians
- Investigate the AP course offerings in Psychology, English, Calculus, and Studio Art
- If you are already taking advanced classes and want to continue, include these course selections in MSS
- NOTE: If you are thinking of taking AP Psychology, you need to schedule Psychology 20 AP and Psychology 30 AP in the same year.

When is the 2025-2026 Registration deadline?

- On-line registration - done at home through My School Sask (MSS) takes place from **Wednesday, February 26th, 2025 to Wednesday, March 5th, 2025**
